



BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 091, SERIES OF 2012

ORDERING THE SYNCHRONIZATION OF THE EXPIRATION OF REGISTRATION FOR GOVERNMENT PROJECTS WITH THAT OF CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE ON JUNE 30

WHEREAS, Item 4.4 of the Revised Guidelines for Registration and Classification of Contractors approved on 01 March 1991 provides, among others, that a Filipino contractor (a Filipino citizen, partnership or corporation duly organized and licensed under the laws of the Philippines and at least seventy five per cent (75%) of the capital stock of which belongs to Filipino citizens), which has been duly registered for government projects shall be issued a regular Certificate of Registration valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of its issuance;

WHEREAS, Rule 3, Sec. 3.2 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 4566 provides, among others, that a regular license shall be valid for one fiscal year, from the 1st of July to the 30th of June of the ensuing year;

WHEREAS, both the contractor's license and registration particulars form part of a contractor's license certificate which has to be re-issued after the June 30 expiry date of license and after the three-year registration validity which may fall any time on the 3rd year;

WHEREAS, the different expiry dates for license and the registration pose administrative problem on the part of the contractor considering the time, effort and cost involved in the process;


WHEREAS, the PCAB believes that synchronization of the expiry month and day of the license and registration has to be made to promote processing efficiency and reduce the cost of doing business on the part of contractors by simply filing one renewal application for both license and registration before June 30 based on the existing policy on monthly staggered renewal filing when the latter expires on the 3rd year;

IN VIEW THEREOF, the Board **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to order the synchronization of the expiry date of license and registration on June 30 to be implemented effective immediately as follows:

- a. All new registration and re-registration for government projects to be issued thereafter shall have June 30 as the expiry month & day on the 3rd year;
- b. Corresponding adjustments in terms of registration validity dates and registrations fees have to be made to have this synchronization possible, such that validity dates may exceed three years and registration fees may increase proportionately during the first three years of implementation of this policy until such time that the license and registration expiry dates are fully synchronized.
