



**Board Resolution No. 270
Series of 2011**

**GRANTING OF ADDITIONAL CREDIT POINTS TO ISO CERTIFIED
CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS AS AN INCENTIVE**

Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of R.A. 4566 (Contractor's License Law) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) adopted a system of categorization of contractors based on their financial, technical and track record qualifications quantified in terms of equivalent credit points;

Whereas, there are construction contractors who are already certified by or undergoing the certification process of International Organization for Standardization (ISO) to promote quality in their processes, ensure compliance with statutory laws on environmental protection, and to promote the safety, health and welfare of their workers;

Whereas, on top of credit points earned based on contractors' financial, technical and track record qualifications, the PCAB recognizes the initiative of contractors to gain quality on different aspects of their operation;

Whereas, as an incentive, PCAB shall grant ISO certified contractors a total of one hundred fifty (150) additional credit points for categorization purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Board **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to grant a total of one hundred fifty (150) additional credit points for categorization purposes of contractors who have successfully gained certification from authorized certifying body under the International Organization for Standardization broken down as follows:

ISO 14001:2004	-	50 points
OSHAS 18001:2007	-	50
ISO 9001:2008	-	<u>50</u>
	Total	150 points =====
