



**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 635
Series of 2012**

**COMPLETION OF THE TWO-DAY AMO SEMINAR AS PREREQUISITE
REQUIREMENT TO FILING OF APPLICATIONS
FOR NEW CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE**

WHEREAS, Section 20 of RA 4566 (the Contractor's License Law) requires that the proprietor/Authorized Managing Officer (AMO) of a construction firm must show knowledge of building, safety, health and lien laws of the Republic of the Philippines and the rudimentary principles of the contracting business as the Board deems necessary for the safety of the contracting business of the public;

WHEREAS, to assure compliance with the requirements of the abovestated law, the PCAB has required the completion of a two-day seminar for proprietors/AMOs with the said requirements as its course content;

WHEREAS, in its initial stage of implementation, only renewal applicants were required to complete the AMO Seminar prior to filing of the corresponding renewal application;


WHEREAS, Sec. 20 of RA 4566 does not distinguish whether the applicant for the contractor's license is a renewing applicant or a new contractor;

WHEREAS, for public interest, it is best that from inception, a new applicant be knowledgeable of the requirements of safety and health, as well as the technical and administrative aspects of construction;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board RESOLVES as it is hereby RESOLVED that starting CFY 2012-2013, a non-delegable completion of the two-day AMO seminar for proprietors/AMOs shall likewise be a prerequisite requirement to the filing of an application for new contractor's license .
