REVISED PCAB INTERVIEW GUIDELINES

Whereas, Section 19, Article IV of Republic Act 4566, otherwise known as the Contractor's License Law, has authorized the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board to investigate, classify and qualify applicants for contractor's license by written or oral examination, or both;

Whereas, Section 20, Article IV of the contractor's License Law provides that the applicant is required to show at least two years experience in the construction industry, and the knowledge of the building, safety, health and lien laws of the Republic of the Philippines and rudimentary administrative principles of the contracting business as the Board deems necessary for the safety of the contracting business of the public;

Whereas, oral examination has been proven effective in assessing whether the proprietor or nominated authorized managing officer (AMO) of the firm is indeed in possession of the above-required minimum experience to manager his/her construction firm;

Whereas, Board Resolution No. 184, Series of 2011, provided for the interview guidelines based on existing procedure in conducting interview, members of the PCAB may individually handle the interview, stating among others that full Board interview may be conducted on a case-to-case basis, as the need arises; and

Whereas, there is a need to revise the existing interview guidelines in conformity with the "Ease of Doing Business Act", in line with the streamlining act and to ensure effectiveness and consistency in the conduct of AMO interview shall be put in place.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing and to ensure effectiveness and consistency, the Board RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED to adopt the following revision on the interview guidelines:

All interview guidelines stated in Board Resolution No. 184, Series of 2011 shall still be effective except for the following:

1. The New AMO for Corporations, which are wholly owned by Filipino citizens and have changed their AMO, shall not be required to undergo AMO interview.
2. AMO's of construction firm's who have upgraded their license with less than two notches shall not be not be required to undergo AMO interview; and

3. The above two paragraphs notwithstanding, AMO's of construction firms may still be required to undergo AMO interview if the need arises and recommended by the evaluators.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.


